Mr. van Beuren divides his time between roles in Corporate Governance, Family Office oversight, and Philanthropy. He spent the majority of his career as a business leader at the Campbell Soup Company.

He serves on the boards of directors of the Campbell Soup Company, an \$8B Net Sales branded food company; Bissell Inc, a \$1B Net Sales leader in homecare durables; and Brandywine Trust Group, a non-depository Trust Company and wealth management entity with \$10B AUM. He chairs the governance committee at Campbell Soup, and serves as Vice Chairman of Brandywine and Bissell where he chairs the audit and governance committees respectively. He sits on the American Advisory Board of Christie's auction house.

During his twenty-six years at Campbell Soup Mr. van Beuren served in numerous leadership roles including: President of Global Sales and Chief Customer Officer, President of Campbell's Canada, Mexico and Latin America, President of Godiva Chocolatier, and Managing Director of Campbell's U.K. Grocery Division. In November 2009 he was elected to Campbell's Board of Directors.

On the Philanthropy side, Mr. van Beuren is past chair of the van Beuren Charitable Foundation, a Rhode Island based not for profit committed to enhancing the quality of life and quality of place on Aquidneck Island. The foundation supports initiatives in healthcare, education, economic development, urban planning and historic preservation in the state of Rhode Island. He currently serves as a board member

and chairs the Nominating Committee.

Mr. van Beuren earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Yale University in 1979, and his MBA in finance from Columbia University in 1983.

He and his wife Helene reside in Bryn Mawr, PA with their two children. Helene is active in animal welfare causes.
